Sample Job Description

TITLE OF POSITION: Functional Family Therapist

IMMEDIATE SUPERVISOR: Director of Functional Family Therapy Programs

SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES: The implementation site uses the Functional Family Therapy (FFT) modality with (target population(s) – (each) with its own referral and reporting requirements. This program operates under the direction of the director of FFT. The therapist will provide, at a minimum, weekly one-hour, home-based family therapy sessions to clients. Therapist will utilize the FFT model with families who have adolescents between the ages of 10 and 18. Therapist will be required to carry a caseload of 10 to 15 families, providing services anywhere from eight to 26 weeks. This position requires flexibility in hours to meet families when they are available.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Master's degree in social work, counseling, education or other relevant human service profession, with two years experience in children and family services
- 2. Ability and willingness to work with families in their own homes
- 3. Flexibility to work when the families are available to meet
- 4. Ability to work independently, as well as contribute to a team
- 5. Very good interpersonal/communication skills
- 6. Strong clinical skills
- 7. Ability to internalize and work within the FFT philosophy and model
- 8. Ability to work with adolescents
- 9. Ability to work with respect for cultural diversity
- 10. Ability to engage families who may not want the service
- 11. Ability to adapt and individualize program interventions to utilize family strengths and skills
- 12. Commitment to empowering families to solve their own problems
- 13. Belief in the capacity of people to grow and change
- 14. Ability to establish a mutually respectful relationship, in which the family is a full partner, empowered to solve their own problems
- 15. Ability to intervene decisively, when necessary, to protect family members
- 16. Ability to set appropriate boundaries and limits for best practice

HOURS PER WEEK: This is a full-time exempt salary position, utilizing a flex schedule. **FUNCTIONS:**

- 1. Carry a caseload as assigned
- 2. Provide home-based FFT to families
- 3. Actively participate as part of the therapy team
- 4. Assist families by actively referring them to appropriate services and supports
- 5. Assist families with both clinical and concrete services
- 6. Perform the basic accountability tasks related to the job, which include compiling and maintaining all necessary records
- 7. Assist administrative staff in collection of information for program effectiveness
- 8. Perform other duties as requested by your direct supervisor, the program director or the CEO
- 9. Responds in a positive and respectful manner to diversity, among the agency's se
