

Checklist of Training Steps Required for Certification of an IY Classroom Dina Peer Coach

The training requirement of an experienced Incredible Years Peer Coach involves a process similar to that for Group Leader Certification. The difference is that Peer Coach training embraces a broader experience in supervision principles and components of providing videotape review and support to new group leaders. When all the training steps (listed below) are achieved, observed and confirmed, a candidate may apply for accreditation/certification as a qualified IY Peer Coach.

Step 5 Application for Classroom Dina Child Peer Coaching Accreditation:

When all of the above training experiences have been achieved, observed and confirmed, a candidate may apply to the Incredible Years Advisory Council for Accreditation and Certification as a Qualified IY Classroom Dina Peer Coach.

Note: It is important for group leaders to realize that obtaining peer coaching on their video does <u>not</u> satisfy the final qualifications for accrediting a group tape. This must still be done by an accredited mentor or trainer
