

#### IYP in Aotearoa New Zealand

• 116 panel of providers currently contracted to deliver the Incredible Years across Aotearoa New Zealand.

 Around 35,000 caregivers have attended a programme from the IY suite since its inception in 2010.

For every \$1 invested into IYP, \$3.75 is gained in social capital





#### The Data


 Collected from the New Zealand Ministry of Education (MoE) National Register and Whāraurau.

# IYP Participant Numbers




12,468 - Total number of participants who attended an IY Parent programme contracted by NZ's Ministry of Education between 2017 - 2021.

# Psychometric Data – Eyberg Intensity




#### 2021 Data

60% of children in the clinical range at the beginning of the programme

26% of those children remain in the clinical range at the end of group.

Average 26% of those children remain in the clinical range at the end of group.



## Psychometric Data – Social Competence

% of target children whose parents attended the course, who showed improvement in social competency scores.






## Maori Workforce Maori Group Leaders actively delivering

- 51 Group Leaders delivering IYP across Aotearoa
- 16 Group Leaders delivering IYT across Aotearoa
- 4 Group Leaders delivering IYP-A across Aotearoa
- 1 Group Leader delivering IYT-A

Majority of Māori Group Leaders are based in the North Island with the regions of Tai Tokerau, Central North and Hawkes Bay most strongly represented
