About the Training

This online training will cover in depth the Autism Spectrum and Language Delays Program for parents of children ages 2–5 years old. This workshop will train group leaders to deliver the Autism Spectrum and Language Delays Program in a parent group setting. This program can be used as a 14-16 week stand alone curriculum for a group of parents all of whom have children on the Autism Spectrum or with language delays. It can also be used by group leaders delivering the Toddler or Basic Preschool IY Programs as a supplement if there are parents in the group with children on the Autism Spectrum or with language delays.

To attend this training, group leaders should have prior experience working with children on the autism spectrum or their families. Prior experience with running Incredible Years Parent groups is not required, although highly recommended, and experienced IY Basic group leaders are welcome! Our online trainings are intended to be highly interactive and collaborative. Attendees should plan for active participation!

About the Trainer

Sue Evans, M.Ed., Ed.D. is a Consultant Child Psychologist. Sue is a certified trainer in many of the Incredible Years parent programs, including the IY Autism and Language Delay programme. Sue is also a trainer in the IY teacher programmes. She is now semi-retired from her post as Consultant Child Psychologist for Parenting and Childrens' Social Competence programmes with a health board in mid-Wales. For many years she has offered training and supervision in a range of IY programmes to agencies in her local area, and also offered training and supervision to agencies across Wales in her prior role as honorary Lecturer at Bangor University. Sue has been involved in a number of research trials linked to IY programmes. Sue led a team that previously won the NHS Wales award for "Working Seamlessly Across Organizations" in delivering the IY programmes online as a way of continuing access to services during the pandemic. Prior to being involved with IY programmes, Sue worked for many years as an Educational Psychologist both in Wales and in England. Her doctoral work involved the development of solution-focused, collaborative consultation groups for teachers.





Goals of the parent training series:



- Increase parents' positive relationships, sensitivity, and attachment with their children.
- Increase parents' understanding of Autism Spectrum Disorder and encourage developmentally appropriate expectations.
- Increase parents' strategic use of focused and positive attention with children by means of coaching skills, imaginary and creative play interactions, praise and responsive feedback, and reduce the use of criticism, unnecessary commands and negative attention.
- Increase parents' understanding of how to promote their children's cognitive, emotional, social, and language learning.
- Increase family support networks and reduce stress.
