About the Training

This online training will present in depth the Classroom-based Dinosaur Curriculum Program designed by Dr. Webster-Stratton to help prevent behavior problems and promote social competence and emotional literacy in young children. The program focuses on ways for teachers to promote children's emotional literacy, anger management, appropriate conflict management strategies, expected classroom behaviors, and positive social skills or friendship behaviors with other children and adults.

The curriculum includes over 60 lesson plans for use by teachers for children aged 3-8 (curriculum is broken up into three "levels" for different developmental stages). The training also includes classroom management strategies which enhance children's prosocial skills and reduce behavior plans. The program is appropriate for use by teachers and school counselors for classrooms of students in groups of 18 to 24. It includes circle time, small group activities and strategies to promote social, emotional, and academic literacy throughout the day. - Strengthen children's social skills and appropriate play skills (turn-taking, waiting, asking, sharing, helping and complimenting).
- Promote children's use of self-control strategies as effective problem-solving steps and effective anger management strategies.
- Increase emotional awareness by labeling feelings, recognizing the differing views of oneself and others, and enhancing perspective taking.
- Boost academic success, reading and school readiness.
- Reduce defiance, aggressive behavior, and related conduct problems such as noncompliance, peer aggression and rejection, bullying, stealing and lying.
- Decrease children's negative cognitive attributions and conflict management approaches.
- Increase self-esteem and self-confidence.
